ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

1. 2019 single page entry form, printed on both sides; typed or handwritten; must include **ORIGINAL HANDWRITTEN SIGNATURES** (owner, rider, trainer and coach, if applicable). Please have email address legible for confirmation of ride times.
2. Emergency contact to be included.
3. Include copies of membership or identification cards for each owner, rider, trainer and horse, as applicable. Include a photocopy of a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of the show date. In accordance with USEF Rule GR845, please include proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within 6 months prior to the date of the show. **THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.**

5. Entries must be postmarked by the closing date. Late fee - \$20.
6. Illegible or incomplete entries may be returned or charged a \$10 surcharge for secretary completing or correcting entry form.
7. No refunds after the closing date or for "Acts of God", hazardous weather, or other emergencies which require management to cancel classes or show.

MANAGEMENT NOTES:

1. Entries must be postmarked by the closing date.
2. Refunds before closing date, minus \$30 office fee; No refunds after closing date. No refunds for "Acts of God", hazardous weather conditions or other emergencies which may require management to cancel the show.
3. Post entries accepted, space permitting, with fee of \$20.
4. Freestyle class entries require copies of qualifying tests at that level to be submitted at time of entry. Riders should submit music to the announcer's booth upon arrival at the show. Music should be clearly labeled with instructions and the horse/rider names.
5. Management reserves the right to cancel/combine classes or change judge at its discretion.
6. Ribbons through sixth place awarded for each class. Prize for first place. Championship and Reserve Ribbons if there are 3 or more riders in each class of the level.
7. Tentative riding times available at www.suddenlyfarm.com as soon as schedule is finalized, but no later than 3 days prior to show. Schedule will be considered final by 12 noon the day before the show.
8. Sharps container will be available near the Secretary Stand. The safety coordinator is Ellen Brindle-Clark.
9. Emergency Plan, with phone numbers, will be posted at the Secretary's Stand.
10. Show tends to fill up quickly, so enter early.

SHOW GROUNDS:

1. Footing: Competition will be held outside, in standard Dressage arena, with sand footing. Warm-up is available in indoor arena with sand footing. The next 3 or 4 "on-deck" riders may warm up in the sand area in front of the Dressage arena.
2. Lungeing is permitted on the grass in the parking area, not in the indoor or in the sand ring
3. Protective headgear must be worn at all times when mounted.
4. Bridle numbers must be worn whenever horses are out of the trailers/stalls.
5. Non-competing horses must be registered and must also wear bridle numbers.
6. **DOGS ARE NOT PERMITTED ANYWHERE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
7. Professional services: contact number will be posted at secretary's stand. EMT on site; Vet and Farrier on call.
8. Directions can be found on your GPS using 325 Main Street Lumberton, N.J. 08048, or on the suddenly farm website.
9. Food will be available on the grounds.
10. Stabling is not available.
